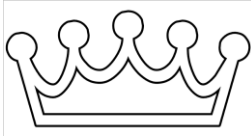

# **GUIDELINES FOR THE JR. FAIR PRINCE/PRINCESS COMPETITION**



Any male (single, never married, nor a parent of a child) or female, (single, never married, nor having been or currently pregnant or a parent of a child) ages 11-14 years of age (as of January 1, 2021), who is also an active member of any youth organization participating in the Jefferson County Junior Fair is eligible to compete. Other than minor or petty offenses, applicant can never have been convicted of any criminal offense and have no criminal charges currently pending.

Contestants must fill out an application/autobiographical form. Signatures are required on application. No application will be accepted without appropriate signatures. Interviews will be held on **Wednesday, August 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.** at the fairgrounds in the Kitchen. **Plan to be at the Kitchen by 5:30 p.m. for pictures.** Your Application/Autobiographical form will be due by **July 10<sup>th</sup>.** **NO FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE.**

Interview scoring will be based on activities, achievements, poise, appearance, presentation and personality. Decisions are made based on completed application and the personal interview. No other support materials will be considered. Prince and Princess will be identified immediately following the interviews on Wednesday, August 4<sup>th</sup> and presented at the Jr. Fair Coronation on Monday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. No court will be selected.

## **Prince and Princess responsibilities will be:**

- **Participate in the Coronation Ceremonies on Monday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. NO ESCORTS ARE NEEDED!**
- **Princess is expected to wear a party dress (below the knee or longer).**
- **Prince is expected to wear dress slacks or khakis and dress shirt (no jeans or hats).**
- **Wear sash at all times unless competing in an event at the fair. If you are showing, no sash or crown will be worn.**
- **Be available for pictures with champions as needed at the Livestock Sale.**
- **Ride in the parade. The parade takes place at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday of fair week. Line up at 9:00 a.m. You will need to work with the Junior Fair Coordinator to secure transportation for parade.**
- **The tiara will be provided for the princess.**
- **The 2021 Prince/Princess may be asked to make several appearances throughout the 2021/2022 year to represent the Jefferson County Fair.**





## GUIDELINES FOR THE JR. FAIR KING/QUEEN COMPETITION

Any male (single, never married, nor a parent of a child) or female, (single, never married, nor having been or currently pregnant or a parent of a child) ages 16-19 years of age (as of January 1, 2021), who is also an active member of any youth organization participating in the Jefferson County Junior Fair and a resident of Ohio is eligible to apply. Other than minor or petty offenses, applicant can never have been convicted of any criminal offense and have no criminal charges currently pending.

Applicants must have at least 3 consecutive years as a member of the youth organization they are representing in this competition.

Contestants must fill out an application/autobiographical form. Signatures are required on application. No application will be accepted without appropriate signatures. Interviews will be held on **Monday, August 2nd at 6:00 p.m.** at the fairgrounds in the Kitchen. **Plan to be at the Kitchen by 5:30 p.m. for pictures.** Your Application/Autobiographical form will be due by **July 10<sup>th</sup>**. **NO FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE.**

Interview scoring will be based on activities, leadership qualifications, achievements, poise, appearance, presentation and personality. Decisions are made based on completed application and the personal interview. No other support materials will be considered. Finalists will be selected by the judges and the announcement of the 2021 Court will be made after all interviews have been completed the evening of August 2nd.

The Junior Fair King and Queen will be crowned from the Court on **Monday, August 16th** during the opening of the fair. Finalists will be given specifics after judging is completed.

### **Royalty and Court responsibilities include, but are not limited to:**

- *Queen contestants are expected to wear evening gowns for the coronation and the parade and the King contestants are expected to wear dress slacks and sport coats for same. (No jeans or hats will be permitted)*
- *Wearing sashes/rosettes at all times, except when showing your livestock project*
- *Working the livestock sales*
- *Handing out awards at the livestock shows*
- *Working Jr. Fair Shows (unless you are showing in a specific show)  
(The Court and King/Queen will work with the Jr. Fair Coordinator to divide responsibilities of all Jr. Fair Shows)*
- *Riding in the parade*
- *The parade will take place on Saturday, August 21st at 10:00 a.m. Line up at 9:00 a.m. You will need to work with the Junior Fair Coordinator to secure parade transportation.*
- *The 2021 King and Queen may be asked to make several appearances throughout the 2021/2022 year to represent the Jefferson County Fair.*
- *Tiaras are provided by the Fair Board for the Royalty Court, and a Full Crown will be provided to the Queen by the Fair Board. A crown will not be provided for the King. (This supersedes what is printed in fair book).*
- *Successful applicants must meet all contestant criteria and be able to represent Jefferson County in the State Pageant. They must also comply with all rules set down by the Ohio Fair Managers Association.*





## 2021 JR. FAIR KING/QUEEN\* INFORMATION SUMMARY

### CROWNING:

Crowning will be held on Monday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. Please be at the Rozsa Entertainment Pavilion at 4:45 p.m. with your escort. Crowning will take place immediately after the opening ceremonies.

### ESCORTS:

Royalty escorts must adhere to the same attire requirements as the Court. Escorts should be Jefferson County youth between the ages of 14-21. Escorts are needed for the coronation only. Each court member is responsible for securing their own escort.

### LIVESTOCK SHOWS:

The candidates will work with the Coordinator to make sure there is a representative at each show.

**Royalty will wear sashes at all times when attending fair activities.** The exception is that if you are showing, no sash, crown, tiara, pin or hat can be worn while you are competing. Nothing can be worn that designates you as Fair Royalty.

### PARADE: Saturday, August 21st

One Car and One Sign for King and Queen

One Sign for each Court member

Court may share a car as needed.

Dress Clothes for Men and Evening Gowns for Women.

The Coordinator will provide the signs for the vehicles.

### LIVESTOCK SALE:

Saturday, August 21st at 12:00 Noon. King and Queen need to be on hand for Grand and Reserve pictures of each species.
